


## What are we doing at Nursery this week? Morning Children

Reinforcing our rules and routines




 Finding out about our daily rules and routines, especially washing our hands properly, before eating at café, after going to the toilets and throughout our time at nursery

 Following sequences of movements during dancing and assault course activities




 Talking about people who are familiar to us as we draw pictures of our daddies

 Learning to use tape to stick bottle tops to create a caterpillar
















As we work in partnership with parents/carers we ask that you continue to enhance your child's learning and development this week through sharing and exploring with some or all of the following activities which you can enjoy together:

- Encourage your child to use positive language to talk about themselves and their abilities. Share stories about managing feelings, negotiating problems, resolving conflicts and sharing. Give children the vocabulary to describe their feelings and 'notice' positive actions, praising where appropriate.
- Help your child to find out about growth by planting seeds at home and caring for them as they germinate. Show them photographs of themselves as a baby and talk to them about how much they have grown.
- When out at the park or play area, encourage your child to think about safety when tackling new challenges. Enable them to manage their own risk by talking about how high they feel comfortable climbing and what might happen if they go near swings when in use, etc.
