 We are talking about past and future this week at Little Lambs. Talk to your child about what they were like as a baby and how they have grown up. Our caterpillars have now emerged as butterflies, and we will be releasing them this week. Help your child to learn how to look after butterflies in the garden by creating your own butterfly feeder. Butterfly Feeder ou need: Screwdriver Beads String or twine Plastic lid or pot Carefully make three holes in the plastic lid. Thread beads onto the string and push through the holes, knotting to hold on place. Tie at the top, ensuring butterfly plate is level. Find a bright, sunny spot in the garden and hang in place. Fill with ripe, soft fruits like strawberries, oranges or apples.
