Important notice regarding Music Time

We are beginning our popular Music Time sessions for morning children after our summer break. These are structured music sessions led by a qualified music teacher whose services we buy in. She is early years experienced and the children who took part in these sessions in previous years have thoroughly enjoyed them. Rhythm and other music skills are also pre-reading skills, so the sessions also help children acquire knowledge to progress in letters and sounds.

These sessions will be run in their room groups of up to 12 children on Tuesday mornings before half term, commencing on 9th September, with the exception of week commencing 29th September when the session will be on Wednesday and week commencing 13th October when the session will be on Thursday. Sessions will last for 30 minutes each and there will be a total of 7 sessions this half term. We will notify you after half term of the sessions planned before Christmas.

Due to the cost of the teacher, we will charge £2 per session, which will be payable half termly alongside café payments.

If you do not wish your child to take part in the sessions, please let Jen or Clare know as soon as possible.

Uniform



Lots of new uniform has been purchased, so please be sure that it is **clearly labelled** either in indelible ink or with an iron or sew on tag.

Could you also please write your child's name in their **coats** and **shoes**, as many children have the same style, size and width-fitting shoes at this age and confusion can easily arise, especially during role-play situations.

Outdoor Play

At Little Lambs we encourage children to spend time outdoors daily, as time spent engaged in physical activity in the fresh air is essential for healthy children. With this in mind, we ask parents to bring appropriate outdoor clothing for your child. Warm, waterproof coats are a must each day and if you have one, please send an all in one waterproof suit for your child to wear to keep them dry in all weathers.

We would like to remind parents of **Early Education Funded children ONLY** (the funding that each child is entitled to from the term after their third birthday) that a contribution of £2.50 per week is payable for a lovely variety of healthy snacks and fruit/vegetables daily.
