- Role playing Garden Centres



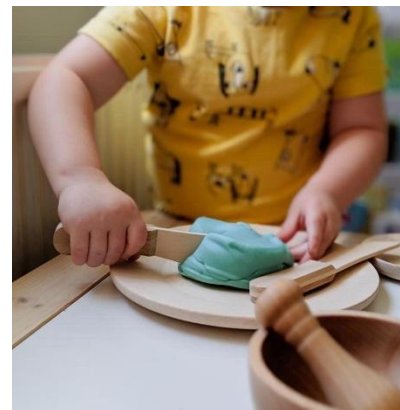
- Comparing length as we thread beads onto different lengths of thread



- Finding out about hot countries and the animals that live there



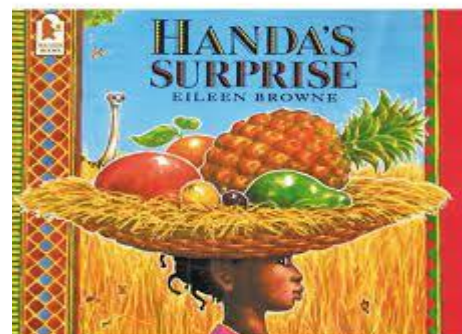
- Using our fine motor skills to manipulate tools whilst exploring and moulding dough

- Investigating fitting ourselves inside and moving through spaces as we explore large box play and tunnels



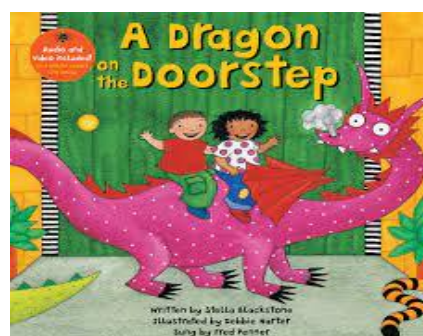
- Playing Hide and Seek outdoors

Working Together to Extend your Child's Learning at Home

As we work in partnership with parents/carers we ask that you continue to enhance your child's learning and development this week through sharing and exploring with some or all of the following activities which you can enjoy together:

- ☀ Encourage your child to use positive language to talk about themselves and their abilities. Share stories about managing feelings, negotiating problems, resolving conflicts and sharing. Give children the vocabulary to describe their feelings and 'notice' positive actions, praising where appropriate.
- ☀ Help your child to find out about growth by planting seeds at home and caring for them as they germinate. Show them photographs of themselves as a baby and talk to them about how much they have grown.
- ☀ When out at the park or play area, encourage your child to think about safety when tackling new challenges. Enable them to manage their own risk by talking about how high they feel comfortable climbing and what might happen if they go near swings when in use, etc.
